The day was broken up into five sessions:

1. What is coaching?
2. What is good listening?
3. How to ask good questions.
4. The Nuts & Bolts of the coaching experience.
5. Where do we go from here?

Attendees were given plenty of opportunity to interact and actually practiced coaching one another.

We look forward to seeing how God uses this training to help raise up leaders for the church.
